

Trafficade Presents Hidden Lake Fall Regatta and Driving School

Come join the Southwest Boat Racing Association and American Powerboat Association for Stock and MOD outboard racing at Hidden Lake in Buckeye AZ on 31 October and 1 November 2020. This will be a 2021 Race, so get on board to garner points early in the 2021 season. The Course is oval and a good ¾ mile and is right in front of the spectator area. 3 days of racing in 2 for all legal classes with bonus day to run on Saturday.

Trafficade presents trophies and prize money for classes with 4 or more entries: \$100, \$60, \$40 for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, for the weekend, respectively. Plus, for overall high points for the weekend, there will be an additional prize of \$250, \$150, \$100 for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, respectively. Additionally, all entries for 3rd day free to the single driver who travels the greatest distance (over 500 miles).

Registration Saturday is 7-8:30AM and Sunday is 7-8AM.

Drivers Meeting Saturday and Sunday 9AM in the pit area.

COVID SAFETY PLAN: This is an outdoor activity and we recommend the following procedures.

1. CONTROL and MANAGEMENT: Camping Areas – Camp sites/RVs and Food Trucks/Bar/Restrooms will be under the control of the land owner as these areas are not in the Restricted “Pit” Area; however they are spaced further apart than usual and the six foot social distancing is in effect. Racing Rigs in the Pit Area will be spaced further apart than usual and teams are encouraged to stay in their own areas as much as possible. Signage of COVID protocols will be placed at the entrance to the pits. Upon arrival, before you unload trailers, your temperature will be checked at the registration table and recorded next to your name. Participants with a temperature above 100.4, will be asked to leave the site.

4. Masking and Distancing. See 1 above. Masking is mandatory at registration and drivers meetings.
5. Hand Sanitizing Stations will be set up at registration, judges stand, inspection, and announcer’s table. Also for the Drivers School, helmet and suit will be cleaned and sanitized.
6. Safety and Rescue Boats.
7. Persons identified with symptoms prior to or during the event will identify this and be expected to quarantine themselves and avoid contact and participation.
8. NOTE: COVID requirement can change quickly due to state and local health department and/or governmental requirements.
9. Announcements will be made over the PA reminding all in attendance to practice social distancing hourly.
