

*** Until the current State Phase 3 guidelines change, the following will apply to the NWPBA 2021 Richland Regatta at Howard Amon Park in Richland, WA, June 25/26/27:

- Each registered boat team will receive pit passes for 6 crew members
- Spectators will not be allowed inside the Pit Area
- The March 2021 Phase 3 Section of the “Healthy Washington Roadmap to Recovery” and Spectator Events” guidelines limit participants to a maximum of 400. These documents may be viewed at www.governor.wa.gov

Preregistration will close 5 days prior to the event. Once the APBA steps are complete, a confirmation email will be sent to you.

1. Use the link from the Club emails or FB to access the APBA registration. It is preferred that you upload your APBA card, and club membership card by following the directions within this page.
 2. The registration team will return an email to the owner/driver with the acknowledgement and confirmation of classes entered as well as the entry fee amount. To limit contact at the event, repayment highly recommended.
 3. The registration team will also request the names for the six [6] pit passes via email.

- Read all the bullet points on the sanction for each race to know where the required check-in location will be prior to pit area entry with the Covid-19 team manager. This volunteer is assigned by the race director and is included in the race committee.
 - All NWPBA BOD members are part of the Covid-19 team.
 - Boat Team owner/leaders will be responsible for Covid screening of all six crew members, each day [temperature checks, question if feeling ok] PRIOR to pit area entry. Participant must have on the correct colored wristband for pit area entry and must be visible.
 - Participants are requested not to hold gatherings and will adhere to the Washington State social distancing guidelines of the recommended 6 foot spacing as much as possible for all three event days.
 - A Drivers only meeting will be conducted each day utilizing a speaker system as needed to accommodate social distancing.
 - Rule of the day: Even if vaccinated, all participants including officials will be required to wear a face covering at all times, with the only exceptions: drivers wearing helmets, and crew members while working in your own immediate pit area with your own team.
 - Crew member access to the staging and live docks will be limited and announced at the driver’s meeting.
 - Each team will provide disinfectant or hand sanitizer available at each boat trailers.
