

## 2021 American Power Boat Association COVID Safety Plan

IF YOU ARE SHOWING ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND EVENT!

\*Per the CDC, symptoms include cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, and new loss of taste or smell. Immediately isolate and seek medical care for any individual who develops symptoms. Contact the local health district about suspected cases or exposure. Work with local health department to identify potentially infected or exposed individuals to help facilitate effective contact tracing/notifications. Once testing is readily available, teat all suspected infections or exposures. Following testing, contact local health department to initiate appropriate care and tracing.

- Spectators and participants are encouraged to maintain six-foot social distancing.
- Spectators and participants are encouraged to wear face coverings
- Spectators and participants are encouraged to wash their hands and use hand sanitizer

Registration for participants will be performed online.

Additional forms will be sent to participants to complete at home and bring to check in.

Driver's meeting will at separate times for APBA Drivers and IJSBA Riders.

Driver's meeting will be with PN officials and Driver and Rider Only and one other person with them.

Cold Pits will be closed to the public and only accessible to Officials, Drivers, Riders and Crew Members.

We will have no Podium Awards Ceremony to prevent gathering of people.

There will be no camping in the cold/hot pit area.

\*Our Venue Cities will control Covid-19 issues and plans in their city owned areas including spectator viewing areas, restrooms, food vendors, gathering places, parking lots, etc.
