Race Class

All participants will take part in an informative class that reviews basic racing rules such as, flags, course markers and how many laps they will be on the course. During the class, each driver will have the opportunity to kneel in a race boat in order to get familiar with the steering and how to position their body prior to the exhibition run.

Safety Gear

When driving a boat, our racers wear protective cut-resistant suits made from Kevlar; Snell rated helmets and a life jacket. These items are provided for all drivers participating. All participants must wear closed toe shoes. You will get wet.
