Covid Safety Plan

- Control and management of the hot pit area: All attendees will be asked if they have had and covid 19 symptoms in the last 14 days. They will adhere to the six feet social distancing recommendation. The restrooms will be stationed six feet apart with hand wash stations on site. Signage that specifically relates to covid protocols will be clearly visible to all race teams, vendors and spectators.
- 2. Chris Barger and Dale Barger will be our liaison with local public health authorities to ensure the event is practicing safe covid recommendations.
- The race committee will encourage all race teams and spectators to practice social distancing throughout the event weekend.
- 4. Hand sanitizing stations will be available at registration, timing booths and inspection.
- 5. We will encourage those on safety boats to wear a mask when not able to social distance. Hand sanitizer will be provided for commonly touched areas such as steering wheels.
- 6. All volunteers and race teams that have any covid 19 symptoms prior or during the event will identify this occurrence and be expected to quarantine themselves and avoid contact and participation for the weekend.
- A cautionary notice that covid 19 requirements can change quickly due to state and local health department and/or government requirements will be noted at the event.
